

## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Polk County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a 2016 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 0.19 percent over the rollback rate.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the Polk County Board of Commissioners Meeting Room, 29 Hugh Hardison Drive, Cedartown, Georgia on the following dates:

July 26, 2016 at 10:00 am.

July 26, 2016 at 6:00 pm.

August 2, 2016 at 6:00 pm.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 11.061, an increase of .021 mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 11.040 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$ 100,000 is approximately \$ 0.84 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$75,000 is approximately \$ 0.63.
